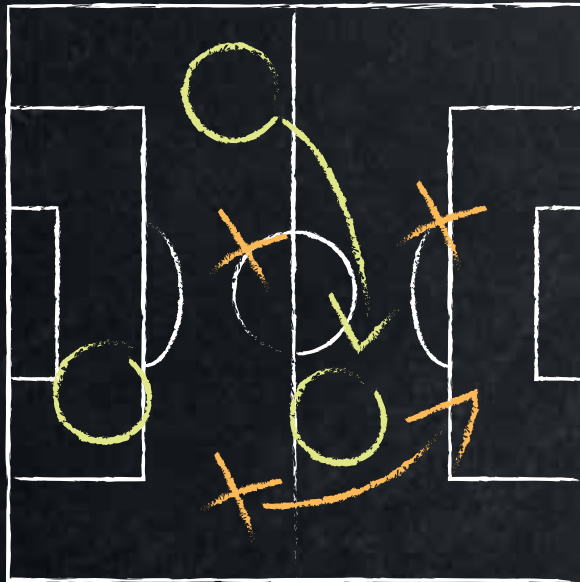
# Our game strategy

# Did you know?

## STATISTICS IN SOUTH AFRICA...



**1 out of 3 girls** are exposed to sexual abuse, that equals **4.2 million**

**25%** of children are exposed to emotional abuse

**1 out of 5** children get badly physically injured

**65%** of all children are exposed to physical abuse

The amount needed per month by a person to live above the "poverty line" is **R531**

**Abuse has an effect on brain development**

- Verbal abuse leads to a hindrance in language development
- Sexual abuse has an influence on abstract thinking and emotional control

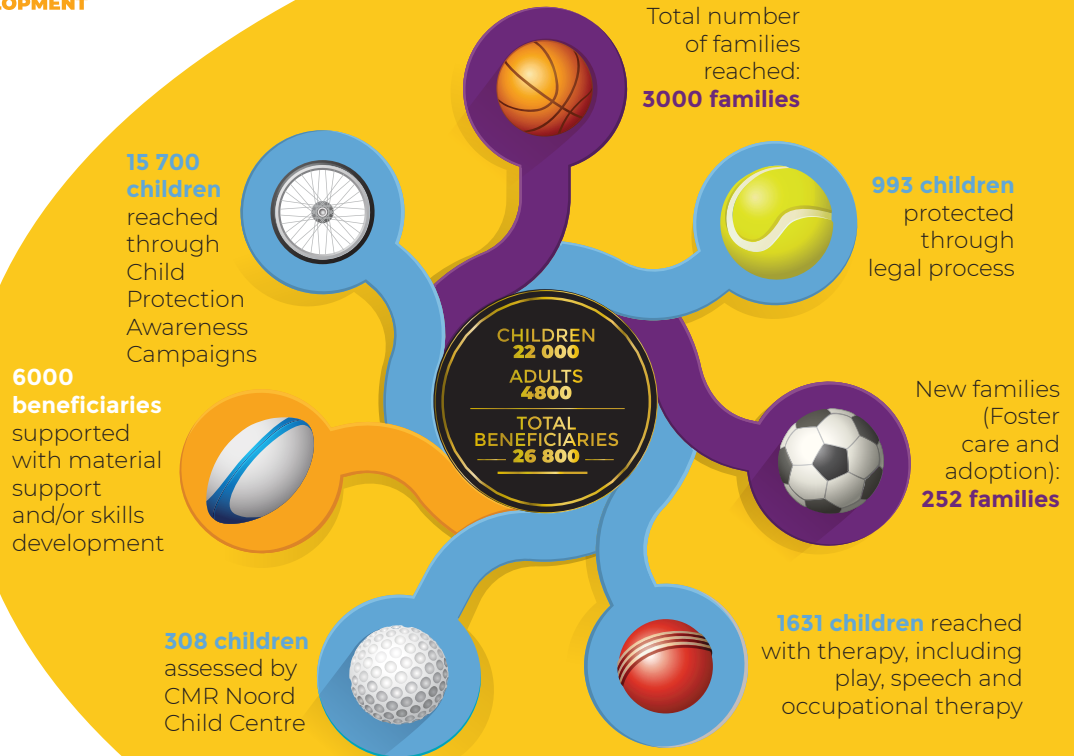

Die beginsel is dat dit beter is om mense te help om selfversorgend te wees as om afhanklik te wees van ander. CMR Noord besef maar alte goed dat dit die ideaal sou wees, maar dat die realiteit nie altyd so maklik is nie. Ons poog dus met ons gemeenskapontwikkeling – en armoedeverligtingsprogram om 'n balans te vind. **Ons ondervinding is dat dit baie moeilik is om iemand te help ontwikkel as hy/sy honger is.** In die geval maak Maslow se piramide baie sin en kan die ontwikkeling baie keer eers gebeur wanneer die basiese behoeftes aangespreek is.

**CMR Noord poog om deur middel van 'n paar intervensies gesinne te ondersteun en veral hul menswaardigheid te herstel.**

- Vaardighedsontwikkeling: Naaldwerkgroepe en ander handvaardigheid
- Materiële ondersteuning deur middel van kospakkies en klere (ongeveer 6000 mense is hierdeur bereik)
- Bewusmakingsveldtogte: Kinderbeskermingsweek en 16 dae van Aktiwisme teen geweld teen vroue en kinders. (bykans 16 000 mense is hierdeur bereik)
- Betrokkenheid by en bestuur van Voorskoolse Ontwikkelingsprogramme.

## KINDERBESKERMING

The most difficult, and many times most unpopular, part of the work that we do is to **formally protect children through the children's court process**. Social workers are bound to the Children's Act to conduct the investigation and report back to court. This is a very divisive intervention. **On the one hand society many times feel that social worker doesn't act fast enough to protect children and on the other hand many communities feel we act to quick**. Social workers many times find themselves between a rock and a hard place and they do need the wisdom of Solomon to make the right decisions.

This intervention is unfortunately many times necessary to ensure that children are safe and that they get the help they need. **In this report, an increase in the number of children we had to formally protect, is sadly reported**. The intensity of these cases is also increasing annually, we find that the factors like the increase in the divorce rate has a significant impact on the emotional health of children.

### **Child Protection Centre (CPC):**

The CPC is one of two specialised Centres of Hope at CMR North.

This Centre mainly **focuses on the Children's court cases in Gauteng**. And it saw a increase in the number of cases (438) it had to deal with.

### **Child Centre:**

The second of the specialised Centres at CMR North which supports the other Centres of Hope with the following **services**:

- Socio-emotional assessments and therapy
- Foster care screening
- Training for potential foster parents
- Adoption services, including screening of parents and placement of children
- Crisis pregnancy support services

# Programme van Hoop

## GESINSBEWARING



### FAMILY PRESERVATION

Gesinsbewaring is CMR Noord se intervensie van keuse. **Uiteindelik wil ons graag eerder sien dat die voorkomingsdienste wat ons lewer nie kan verhoed dat 'n kind deur middel van 'n kinderhofproses beveilig moet word.** Voorkomingsdienste kry gestalte op verskeie maniere in die CMR Noord familie: van die ondersteuning van voorskoolse ontwikkelingsprogramme tot 'n verskeidenheid van terapie tot materiële ondersteuning van gesinne.

Gesinsbewaring sluit verder in om gesinne waar kinders in die verlede moes beveilig word, te ondersteun dat kinders kan terugkeer na hierdie gesin. **Die proses gaan gepaard met baie insette van die maatskaplike werkers wat onder andere terapie en ouerleiding insluit.** Hierdie aspek van die werk wat organisasies doen, gaan baie maal ongesiens verby; dit bly egter 'n integrale deel van die dienste wat ons lewer en 'n fokus area wat al hoe meer aandag geniet.

Die gesinsbewaringsprogram **sluit die volgende** in:

- Groepwerk met kinders
- Ouerleiding en terapeutiese groepe met ouers
- Huweliksberading
- Egskeidingsbegeleiding
- Lewensvaardighede
- Traumaberading
- Terapie by skole
- Om kinders te herenig met gesinne van oorsprong (in 2019 kon CMR Noord meer as 40 kinders terugplaas by gesinne van oorsprong)

# Story of Hope: Our Ambassador

**Ek wil julle graag vertel van hoe die CMR Noord en die Red-'n-Kind Projek 'n volle "Circle of Life" in my lewe voltooi het.**

Anders gestel, indien dit nie vir hierdie organisasie was nie, was ek, sowel as ons 2 dogtertjies, dalk nie vandag hier nie... **hulle RED regtig kinders se lewens!**

Ek is nou 38 jaar oud en is op 10 Junie 1981 gebore in Pretoria Wes. My Ma was toe 16 jaar oud. My biologiese vader was 'n alkoholis. Saam het hulle 4 kinders gehad binne 6 jaar- ek, Johan, Leon en Antoinette. Ek het ook 'n halfsuster, Venessa, wat later uit 'n 2de huwelik gebore is.

For the first 6 years of my life we moved around a lot because my father changed jobs often, always drank and was never home. He used to beat us ruthlessly. My parents were both chain smokers and we had burn marks in our bedding and lived with constant smoke inhalation. I still hate smoking to this day. My father left us when I was about 6 years old. As we were often left alone by my mother, we had to run away from our house - my brother and I used to go play in the park. I made a new "friend" there, a man my Father's age who molested me - something that would stay with me and haunt me for years after.

My Tannie het eendag kom kuier en besef dat ons vir dae lank sonder ouertoesig gelaat is. Sy het ons al 4 in haar kar gelaai en weggeneem... ek was toe 6 jaar oud en in my eerste skool in Graad 1.

Dis hier waar die CMR betrokke geraak het en al 4 kinders beveilig het via die Kinderbeskermings-program of Red-'n-Kind Projek. 'n Maatskaplike werker het my by my tannie se huis kom haal en ek is na die afloop van Kinderhofverrigtinge in pleegsorg geplaas asook in 'n nuwe skool. Na 'n paar pleeg- en veiligheidsplasings wat vir verskeie redes nie uitgewerk het nie, is ek en my jonger boetie Johan, in die Jakaranda Kinderhuis geplaas. Ek het nooit weer my baba boetie gesien nie.

# Story of Hope cont.

Ek was uiteindelik in 5 verskillende skole gedurende daardie jaar. Vanselfsprekend moes ek Gr 1 herhaal.

I stayed in the Children's Home in different "Houses" for the next 13 years and had mostly mixed feelings about this... but it was also the first time I had stability in my life.

There were times that I was rebellious as I missed feeling really loved, and hardly knew any compassion. My fourteenth birthday went by without anybody even congratulating me. I was so sad. I never cut my hair, I didn't go to any classes and I failed grade 10. At the age of 18, I was moved to another house, house no 10. At this stage in my life, I was so used to people leaving me or having little interest in me, I didn't see the genius my CMR social worker had when she moved me to that house. **This social worker obviously cared greatly for me,** otherwise I might have been moved to a school for troubled youth.

My school grades picked up and my sport and cultural participation and leadership grew. This was the best years of my life in the children's home - I passed school well and looked like I had it all together and figured out.

Ek het geen bitterheid of woede meer teenoor my ouers gehad nie. Ek het hulle vergewe tydens 'n Tiener seminaar, maar natuurlik kon ek nooit vergeet nie... Ek het naskool met 'n beurs Sportwetenskap gaan studeer, maar het egter nooit die studies voltooi nie. Ek het eintlik net gegaan om atletiek te doen, aangesien ek in 'n baie goeie naelloper ontpop het in my hoërskooljare.

Ek het atletiek begin afrig na-ure en besef dat DIT werklik my passie was.

Ek het ook in die tyd 'n goeie werk gekry waar ek steeds in diens is na 12 jaar.



# Story of **Hope** cont.

I met my wife Lindie when I was 27. A year later we had a beautiful wedding and she was pregnant shortly thereafter. We were so excited and scared at the same time. I was going to be a daddy. But we lost the baby at an early stage. We were heartbroken, as we learnt that it would be impossible to have children naturally. Lindie had two in-vitro procedures but both failed. It was a tough and stressful time for us.

We talked about other options and I decided to contact the same social worker who cared so much for me during my Children's Home years... her name is Minka. I asked her advice on fostering or adopting a baby through the CMR.

While still considering a third in-vitro procedure, Minka from CMR phoned me one bright morning and informed me of a 3-month old baby that needed a home immediately. We went to fetch Mikayla that same afternoon. The new mommy and daddy had to learn quickly to stay on their feet. This baby took over our lives and made us whole.

**We were a FAMILY.**

Twee jaar later en nog 'n verrassing-dieselfde CMR werker het ons gekontak. 'n Pasgebore babatjie van Pta Wes het 'n huis nodig gehad. Die volgende oggend is ons nuwe babadogtertjie, Ragel, direk van die hospital af na ons gebring. Sy was die kleinste mensie wat ek nog ooit gesien het. Ons het nou 2 pragtige dogters gehad: Mikayla met haar rooi krulhare en blou oë en Ragel wat gebore was met die langste wimpers, donker oë en hare. Ek onthou hoe dit vir my gevoel het of ek deel was van 'n wonderwerk!

**Met die CMR se insette, kon ons nou 2 KINDERS RED, net soos ek met behulp van hulle soveel jare terug ook GERED is....**



# Story of **Hope** cont.

Mikayla is nou 8 jaar oud en in Graad 2, Ragel is 6 en oppad Graad 1 toe. Hulle baklei gereeld met mekaar; eintlik verskil ons almal maar nou en dan - wat beteken ek het uiteindelik 'n normale gesin! Ons het ons eie huis gekoop, ons kinders is in 'n goeie Laerskool en hulle het alles wat enige kind nodig het.

Soos julle kon hoor, het ek baie verloor maar ook so baie gewen in my lewe.

## **Wat ek wel weet is: Besittings maak nie aan kinders 'n verskil nie - mense doen!**

**Kinders het LIEFDE en STABILITEIT nodig.** Op die einde van die dag is ons, die gebroke, verlore kinders dalk nie JOU kind nie, maar ons is almal God se kinders. Ek onthou elke liewe persoon wat iets goed vir my gedoen het en ek is vandag wie ek is as gevolg van mense soos Minka – en is ek vandag nie nie wat die wêreld of my ouers van my kon maak het nie.

Te danke aan organisasies soos die CMR en die Red-'n-Kind Projek, het ek oorleef. Te danke aan JOU wat donasies maak om die CMR Noord aan die gang te hou – het Mikayla en Ragel ook nou beide 'n nuwe lewe!!

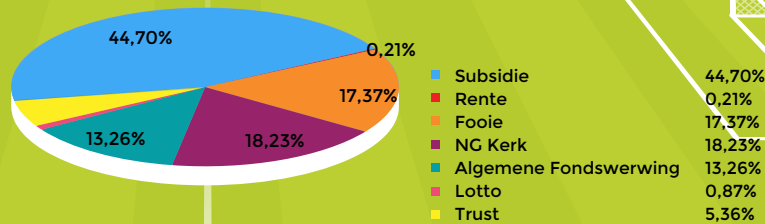

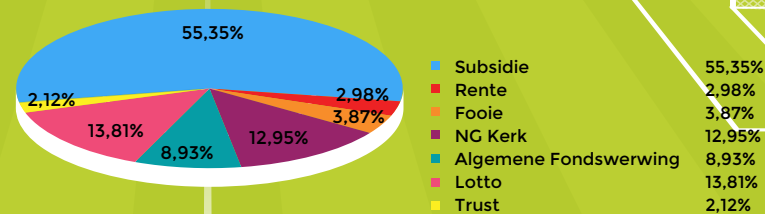

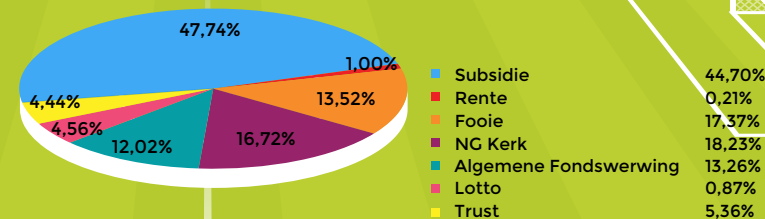
## Diagram 1 Bronne van Inkomste: CMR Noord (Bestuur en Kindersentrum)
